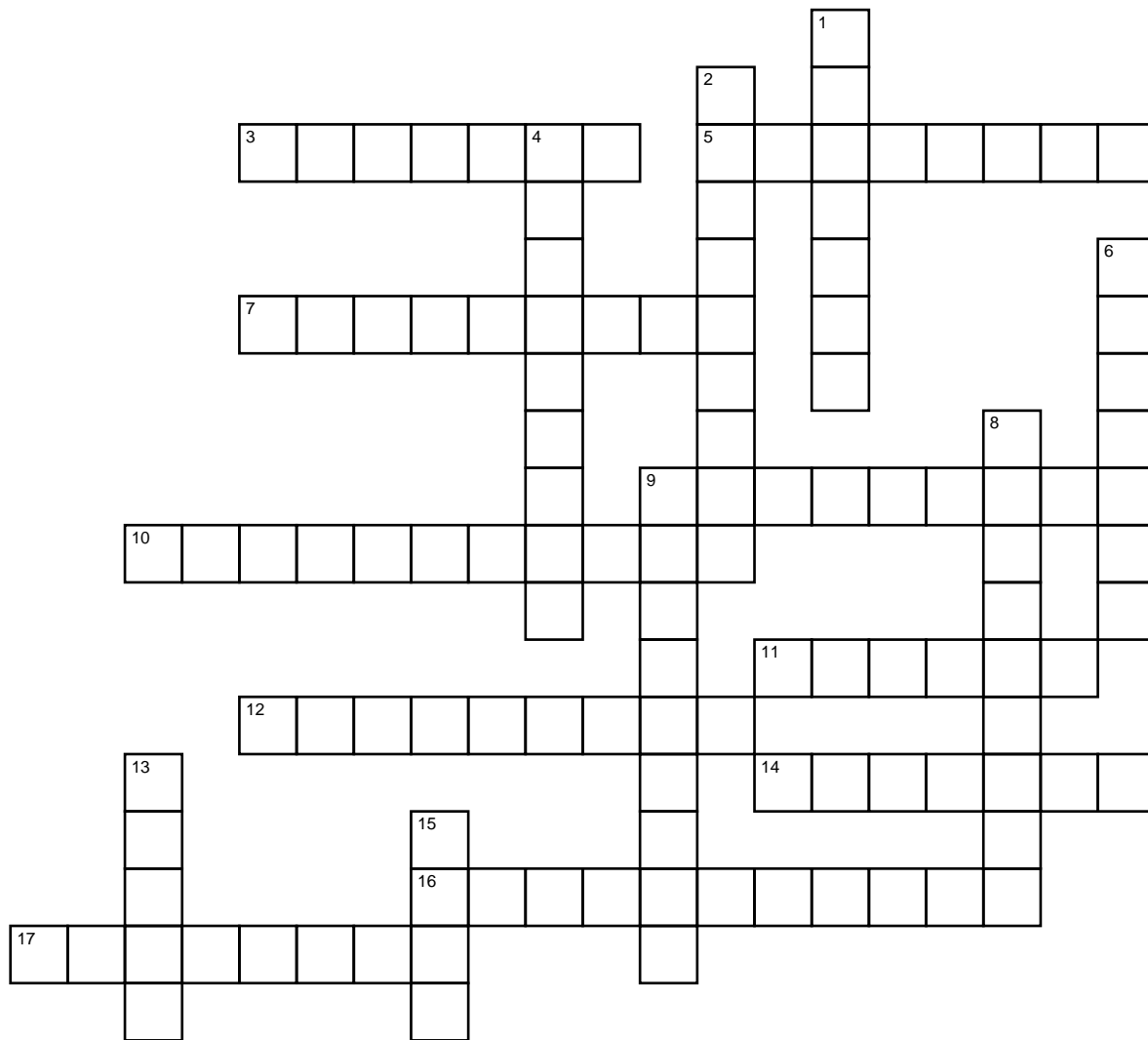

10. Measures designed to preserve health and prevent the spread of disease.
11. A state of complete physical, mental and social well-being, and not merely the absence of disease.
12. A rule or instruction that shows or tells how something should be done.
14. A sick individual, especially under the care and treatment of a healthcare professional.
16. A scheduled meeting with a healthcare professional.

1. Abnormal, scientifically verifiable process occurring in the body.
2. Prediction about the course or outcome of a disease or illness.
4. A skilled healthcare professional trained and licensed to practice medicine, as distinguished from one specializing in surgery.
6. The treatment of injuries or disorders of the body by incision or manipulation, especially with instruments, in order to repair or remove damaged or diseased parts.
