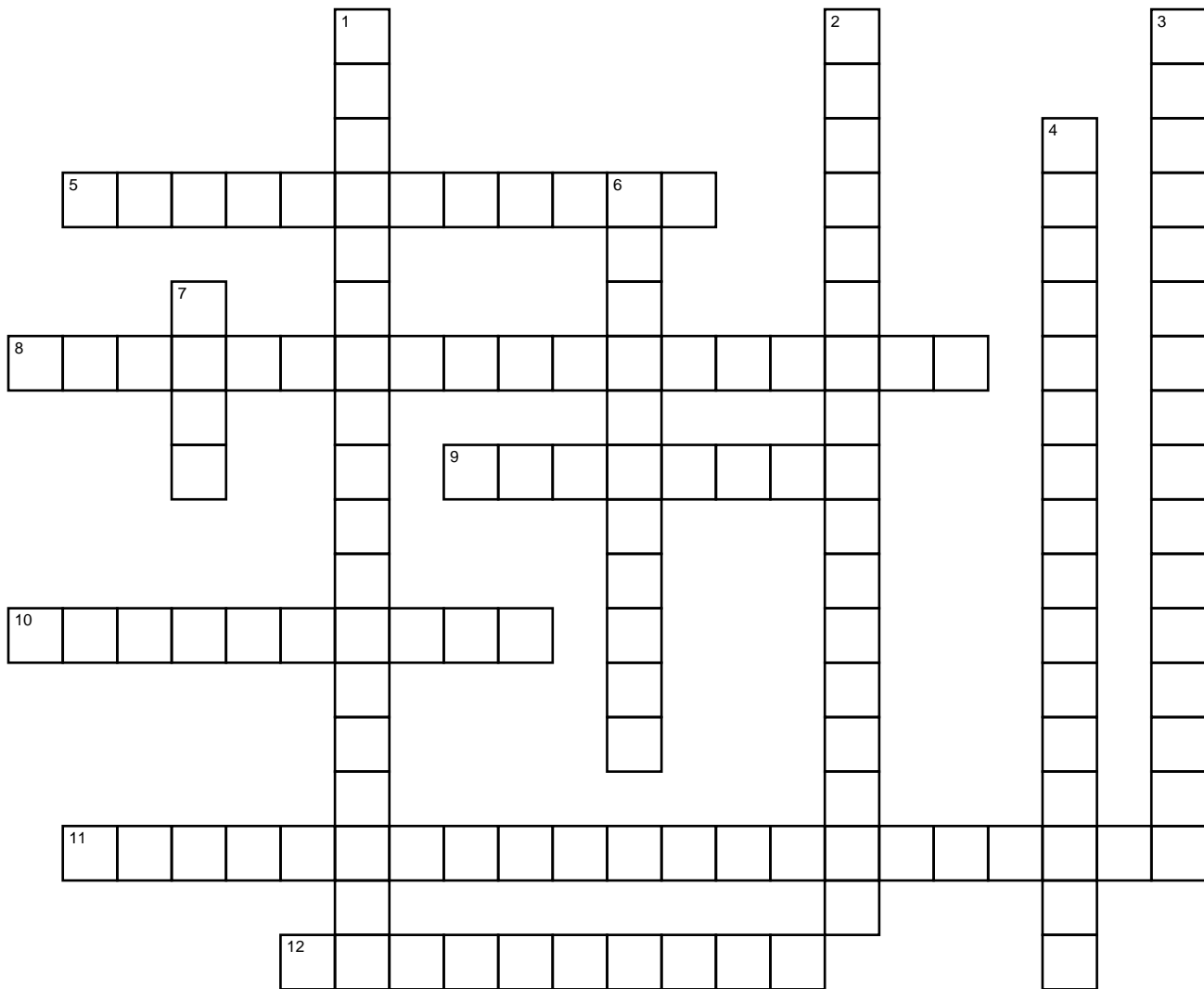

3. Pharmacy practice philosophy that has shifted the focus of pharmacists from drug products themselves to the safe and optimally effective use of drug products in patients.
4. The department of the hospital to manage the procurement, storage, preservation, compounding, preparation, distribution or dispensing of medicines in the hospital.
6. A drug developed to specifically treat a rare medical condition.
